Summer Language Adventure

Duration: Three weeks
Program: Homestay/language study
Start dates: July 3, 10, 17, 24, and 31, 2011
Age level: 15-17 years old
Cost: \$4,200



PROGRAM / COURSES

Learn French with a group of international students while living with a host family in the French Riviera of the south-west. Participants attend morning classes with a qualified native French teacher from Monday to Friday for 2 weeks and take part in activities and tours each afternoon. One full day per week is dedicated to a cultural excursion.

- Courses: 16 classes each week for 2 weeks (1 lesson = approx. 45 minutes)
- Accommodation: home stay family and a single or double room (depending on availability) with full board

ACTIVITIES

One full day and four afternoons per week are dedicated to activities and cultural excursions in the area. Participants will discover Biarritz and visit areas such as Saint Jean de Luz and Bayonne and have the opportunity to take part in golf, beach volleyball, surfing, *basque pelota*, body-boarding and high ropes.

ACCOMMODATION / MEALS

Participants stay with a host family. Living with the locals is the best way to discover the French culture from the inside! Full board is provided, including a packed lunch for school and other outings. Depending on availability, participants will stay in a single or double room. Two participants can stay in the same family, provided they are from different language groups.

TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

- ▶ Have a basic knowledge of French
- ▶ Take the French courses seriously
- ▶ Be motivated

ARRIVAL & LOCAL ASSISTANCE

Participants are transferred from the airport to their host families. Local assistance is provided during the whole stay.

WHAT'S IN, WHAT'S OUT

Included: language courses (as described) and materials • transfers • recruitment of and placement with a host family • accommodation and meals as described • activities as described • local assistance • administrative fees • insurance

Not included: airfares • return transport to airport • personal expenses

HOW DOES IT WORK?

- ▶ Send us a color copy of your passport, including the front and back covers and all pages, including blank ones.

THEN WHAT?

- ▶ You will be sent information to assist in your preparation.
- ▶ You will fly out of the US to begin your adventure.

FEES & DEADLINES

- ▶ Application due April 15 with \$1,000 deposit
- ▶ Full program fee due May 1.
If payment is not received by May 1st, PAX reserves the right to cancel your program.

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

- ▶ Cancellation between May 1 and departure - \$500 non-refundable
- ▶ After departure date – No refund
