Duration: Three weeks
Program: Language study/homestay
Start dates: June 12, 19, 26, July 3, and 10, 2011
Age level: 15-18 years old
Cost: \$4,200

LOCATION

The program is in Cadiz in the southern part of Spain. Cadiz is one of the oldest cities in Western Europe. It is a small and unique city almost completely surrounded by the sea with a population of 160,000 inhabitants. It boasts beautiful beaches and a warm and relaxed atmosphere.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Carefully selected host families provide room and board for the students. Families live close to the Institute in centrally located, clean, comfortable, middle class homes. Living with a family will provide the participant with good conversation and the warmth of a family environment.

ACADEMICS

The staff is comprised of professionals with experience in teaching the Spanish language. Mornings are spent in classes of four 45-minute sessions that offer both Spanish language and Spanish culture. Classes are geared for beginning, elementary or intermediate levels. Class size is about 10-12 students.

ACTIVITIES

The youth of Cadiz enjoy sports and the beach. Students can enjoy chaperoned activities specially designed for them, or they may opt to engage in activities with their host family. There are chaperoned sightseeing trips to both Tarifa and Seville.

MONEY

Students will only need a small amount of pocket money (approximately \$100 a week) for souvenirs, internet/phone calls, snacks and additional beverages. Credit cards are not accepted everywhere. We advise you to buy euro in the US prior to departure.

- ▶ You will fly out of the US to begin your adventure.

FEES & DEADLINES

- ▶ Application due April 15, with \$1,000 deposit
- ▶ Full program fee due May 1. *If payment is not received by May 1st PAX reserves the right to cancel your program.*

CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS

- ▶ Cancellation between May 1 and departure - \$500 non-refundable
- ▶ After departure date – No refund
